From the Pastors Desk

"A Sheepdogs Tale"

"I lift up my eyes to the mountains—where does my help come from? My help comes from the Lord, the Maker of heaven and earth. He will not let your foot slip— he who watches over you will not slumber; indeed, he who watches over Israel will neither slumber nor sleep.

The Lord watches over you— the Lord is your shade at your right hand; the sun will not harm you by day, nor the moon by night.

The Lord will keep you from all harm—he will watch over your life; the Lord will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore." Psalm 121

I have been thinking about the first Sunday that we will be allowed back into our building to worship. It probably is not an exaggeration to say that I have been a bit obsessed with it! I have missed our church family, the smiles, the songs, the children, the entire extended family of the Baldwinsville First United Methodist Church!

When we decided to close our sanctuary and worship on line, we did so reluctantly, but believing fully that it was the safest most loving decision that we could make. Since then, over 125,000 Americans have died due to Covid-19, and best estimates are over 500,000 worldwide. Staggering number.

Now, we are preparing to reopen our sanctuary for corporate worship. We have made this decision with the same prayer and caution that has guided us to date. We plan to continue to offer our 9:00 AM and new 11:00 AM services on line. Many of our saints will likely not feel safe returning to corporate in person worship right away, and we have attracted a significant number of new worshippers from distant locations, and various times during the week that the internet option allows. Imagine, young people in Uganda gathered last Sunday to worship with us! A friend who is not available Sunday mornings joins us faithfully at his convenience on line! With God's help, we will continue this mission.

We will obey all of the rules and restrictions set out by the State of New York and our United Methodist denominational leaders. We are not required to agree with them, or like them, but we will comply as best we are able. I am confident that even with some restrictions and inconveniences, the Spirit of the Lord and many of our dearest loved ones will be present!

To that end, I ask you to self-regulate and protect yourself and our most vulnerable populations. If you are running a temperature or have been exposed to Covid-19, please seek medical attention and join us on the on line platform for worship. We love you, and want to care for you where needed. If you need meals or transportation, please contact the church office so we can help.

Please plan to arrive early for any worship opportunity. We will ask you to register when you arrive, use hand sanitizer and wear a mask. We will keep appropriate social distancing and care for each other while we are allowed to be together.


